The program is focusing on landscape sustainability, integrated soil, water and waste management with focus on mountain regions of Armenia, Georgia and Ukraine. The call for applications starts on 15 December 2018 and ends on 15 February 2019.

The organizers are professors of Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv in cooperation with Centre for Public Initiatives of Kosiv, National Nature Parks “Hutsulshchyna” and “Vyzhnytskiy”, The National Ecological Center of Ukraine and Green Dossier - the nationwide non-profit organizations.

Objectives

Transfer of landscape remedial technologies related to environmentally sound Municipal Solid Waste Management (MSWM) is ambiguous. It has broad area and includes direct and indirect social interactions, as well as transfers of international knowledge, skills and innovation. Carpathian School is going to share the Baltic countries experience in MSWM and landscape safeguarding. Special emphasis will get Quadruple Helix Cooperation that considers universities as a driving force of sustainable society and dissemination of information concerning of human needs in environmental services.

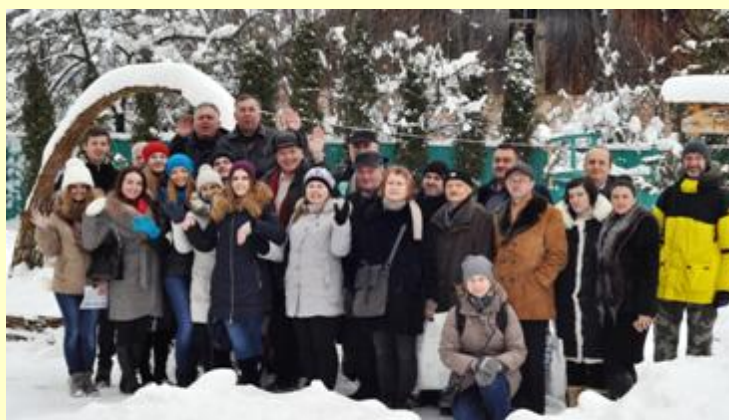
